# 2009 PLANT SALE

**DEADLINE:** All orders must be received by July 17, 2009

**MEMBERSHIP:** In accordance with past practice, the ASI plant sale is for ASI members only. New members are welcome. Membership application can accompany order. Dues for an individual are \$17.50 annual or \$50.50 triennial, family \$21.00 annual or \$54.00 triennial, \$150 lifetime, payable to the Aril Society International.

**PAYMENT:** Please include payment in US dollars with your order. California residents must include sale tax of 9.25%. Make check payable to Aril Society International. We cannot accept credit card payment except through PayPal. To pay using PayPal:

1. Send order to Betsy Higgins
2. An eBill will be sent you with instructions for payment
3. Pay eBill.

**ORDER PRIORITY** is based on postmark, not received date. Priority of orders postmarked on the same day will be decided by the dollar value of the orders.

**You must use the order form from the catalog or one printed off the website.**

If you contemplate placing an additional order within the deadline period, please make a copy of the order form or print the form from the ASI website. Uniformity makes the filling of orders much less time consuming and orders sent on scraps of paper or on paper other than the order form can be easily misplaced or lost.

**REFUNDS:** If you indicate no substitutions on the order form, ASI will refund the cost of any varieties that are not available at shipping time totaling \$10 or more. Refunds under \$10 will be in the form of a coupon for the 2010 Sale.

**SUBSTITUTIONS:** If you indicate you will accept substitutions for unavailable varieties, we will substitute varieties of equal or greater value. You can include a list of preferred substitutions on the order form. Your willingness to accept substitutes will not adversely affect your priority for the varieties ordered.

**ACKNOWLEDGMENT:** All orders with an email address will be acknowledged. **Please print address clearly.**

**EXTRAS:** We try to include something extra with every order. The number and value of your extra will be at our discretion. Your substitution list (if any) will be used as a guide when possible.

**\$25 STUN GUN** OGB (Caroline Chacon 2008) S. medium violet, style arms ivory lined violet; crest violet; F. ivory overlaid violet, darker on lower part, maroon veining and stippling from haft around beards and large maroon black signal; beards grayed violet. **\$25 WADI SAFRA MOONLIGHT** OGB (Chacon 2008) S & F icy blue-white, style arms bright white; purple signal patterned purple from haft to signal; beards yellow. Mondsee X Norris ABN88D1: (tet aril x Earl of Essex)

**\$5 AFROSIAB** RB (A.Volfovich-Moller 1998) I. stolonifera x Mary Frances. S. light purple veined violet and brown, broad brown edge; style arms purple, crests brown; F. cherry purple veined darker, rim brown; orange yellow beards, purple at end; waved form

**\$5 ALADDIN'S TREASURE** OGB- (Pinegar 1993) S. deep bronze, toned greenish, with red splashes; styles same; F. deep bronze, heavily veined red and turning solid red toward bronze edge; dark red spot below dark gold beards LIMITED

**\$10 ANAHEIM DAUGHTER** OGB (Moran 06) S. pale lavender, almost white, infused yellow at midribs; style arms lemon yellow; F. tan, red signal and black spot under beard, white dotting throughout signal spot; beard tan tipped gold, wide. Parentage unknown, seed from SIGNA

**\$12 ANDROMACHE** RC (VanTubergen 1915 BRS) S. lavender violet with distinct veining; F. white with thick maroon purple veining, large purple signal. LIMITED

**\$5 ANTHRACITE** OGB- (Gadd 1987) Black; bronze beard.

**\$5 ARABIAN ARCHER** OGB (Rich 1992) S. lavender veined darker, electric blue midrib; F. oxblood with self veins; black signal with fifteen darker lines; beard yellow.

**\$25 BABYLON PRINCE** - See Introductions

**\$5 BABYLONIAN FIRES** OGB (Rich by Whitely 1992) S. rose lavender with gold midrib; F. rosy tone of orange mahogany, black mulberry signal; yellow beards.

**\$5 BAGDAD'S FOLLY** OGB (Rich by Whitely 1992) S. Off-white with pale orchid veining and faint brushing of bright yellow on midrib; cream style arms; F. Cream ground heavily veined brown; signal orange-rust; beard dark tan.

**\$10 BAKHSHISH** OGB (Ransom 2006) S. medium blue-violet and veined light red-brown; style arms blue violet, rosy brown crests; F. white ground netted and marked purple-violet, dark red-purple center signal; beards tapered light blue tipped blue-violet.

**\$5 BEDOUIN CHILD** OGB+ (McKusick 1974) S. red brown with some stolonifera markings, but lighter; F. same, overall color is richer and darker than stolonifera; metallic blue beard.

**\$5 BEDOUIN WOMAN** OGB (McKusick 1974) S. tan beige yellow; F. red orange brown at signal area beneath style arms; same colors lightening down F; orange yellow beard.

**\$5 BIG BLACK BUMBLEBEE** OGB+ (H. Danielson, 1966). S. deep amethyst-pink, veined mulberry; F. similar, but darker; bronze beard; large black signal

- \$5 BIONIC BURST** OGB (Danielson 1977) S. light red; F. dark red, brownish black beard
- \$5 BIONIC COMET** OGB (Danielson 1987) S. Antique gold; antique gold styles; F. antique gold flushed reddish brown in center, red maroon signal and beard LIMITED
- \$5 BIONIC FOCUS** OGB (H. Danielson by L. Danielson 1991) S. light rose-lavender, veined darker; yellow hafts; yellow style arms and crests; F. light red blend; maroon signal and beard. LIMITED
- \$5 BLUE ARTS** RB+ (L. Danielson, 1986). Bright violet-blue self; pronounced sweet fragrance.
- \$5 BLUMOHR** OB- (Marx 1949) Plumbago blue
- \$5 BRIDESMAID APPAREL** OGB (Danielson 1993) S/ orchid lavender; style crests same with light blue line markings, light yellow style arms with dark lavender at center; F. yellow green, sparsely veined blue from raspberry maroon eyelash signal; pink glow around beards and on hafts; maroon black beards.
- \$5 BRONZE AGE** OGB (Rich by Whitely 1992) S. tan-bronze blend; bronze-yellow style arms; F. bronze; dark brown signal lined darker; bronze beards.
- \$5 BRONZE FALCON** OGB+ (Danielson 1991) S. deep rust, tinged bronze with touch of blue at midrib; light brown crests, purple blue style arms; F. deeper rust, neon purple splash by blue beard.
- \$5 BURRA SAHIB** OGB (Hager 1990) S. pale yellow aging to white; yellow styles; F. yellow, huge dark brown signal; yellowish beard.
- \$5 BUTTERFLY WINGS** OB- (White 1946) S. translucent blue; F. parchment veined mulberry, crimson and russet.
- \$8 CHAIN REACTION** OGB- (Tasco 2007) Reblooms. S. rosy plum lightly veined; F. rosy burgundy lightly veined; brown beard tipped violet, amber in throat.
- \$5 CHOCOLATE MINT** OGB (Tasco, 1998). S. pale violet, aging white; style arms chartreuse buff F. light buff yellow, chartreuse cast; beards dark chocolate brown.
- \$5 CIRCUS PARADE** OGB+ (H. Danielson 1986) S. white flushed lavender, veined tan-yellow on edge; F. white flushed darker lavender, veined tan-yellow on edge; rust red hafts bleeding to side of bright violet beard, deep violet flash below beard.

**\$5 CLOSE CONTACT** OGB (Flanagan, 1989). S. pale violet blended golden tan at midrib; F. golden tan; distinct red-black signal; red-black beard.

**\$5 CONCERTO GROSSO** OGB (Mathes 1998) S & F oxblood red; sharp jet black signal, beards uniform dark blue. LIMITED

**\$5 COPE GOODWIN** OGB- (McAllister 1995) S. very pale blue, hint of violet, style arms very pale blue; F. blue-violet, ¾" signal of deep purple; yellow beard based violet

**\$6 CROWN OF SPLENDOR** OGB (McGrath 2005) S. near white with faint lilac veins; style arms beige gold, light lavender midrib; F. beige gold veining lighter, large dark red signal with some stippling, onco form; beards mustard with near white base, wide.

**\$7 CUP RUNNETH OVER** OGB- (McAllister 2005) S. glistening white, flush of golden yellow at base of midrib; few fine yellow veins extending outward; F. are a complex pattern of golden tan stippled with rust, edged with a broad band of near-white and accented with a flush of soft reddish-violet spreading downward from the tip of the beard. Goblet form showcases prominent golden style arms; veining and stippling increase in the signal area to form a deep purple signal patch.

**\$7 DAMFINO** OGB (McAllister 1998) S. soft grayed rose; style arms yellow, rose midrib and crests; F. blended grayed rose, apricot and rust, small near-black signal in middle of large burgundy spot; beards golden yellow.

**\$5 DARDANUS** RC (VanTubergen before 1960, not registered) Pearly white flower; S. shaded and veined lilac; F have purple veins to match small signal.

**\$5 DEE MOUSE** OGB+ (Danielson 19894) S. ruffled light blue; F. ruffled chartreuse-cream with heavy reddish-brown veining covering most of falls leaving a rim of chartreuse-cream; style arms & crests light blue like stds; large, furry black beard.

**\$5 DESERT DIAMOND** OGB (Hager 1988) Gray blue white, veined deeper near charcoal beards; deep purple signal

**\$5 DESERT FURY** OGB (Shockey 1994) S. dark mulberry red; F. dark mulberry red with broad, diffuse red black signal

**\$5 DESERT PLUM** OGB (Hager 1992) Smokey mauve-purple, silky black-maroon signal; bronze-black beard.

**\$5 DESERT SOLITUDE** OGB- (Flanagan 1993) S. white blended pale amber; F. pale amber flushed pale violet, slightly veined red violet around yellow beards.

**\$5 DESERT SPIRIT** OGB- (Flanagan, 1994). S. pale violet with light violet edge; F. mixture of light violet and light amber; darker violet streak from tip of brown-orange beards; slight fragrance.

**\$5 DORCAS** OGB+ (Hunt 1979) S. light purple, darker toward claw; F. violet with sheen, hafts heavily veined; large red-violet signal

**\$5 DOUG GOODNIGHT** OGB+ (McAllister 1994) Very dark blue violet; style arms with prominent crests; black beards.

**\$5 DOWN PAYMENT** OGB- (Danielson 1988) S. slate lavender with touch of cream at midrib; lavender crests and style arms; F. slate lavender, reddish-brown splash at reddish brown beard, blending to violet.

**\$5 DUNE** OGB- (Hager 1981) Smooth bright brassy gold with gold brown blending and veining around a bronze orange beard; darker stripes from end of beard down petal.

**\$10 EAR FALAS** OGB- (Peyrard 2005) S. gray-white, light yellow edge, lilac veins at base, style arms orange yellow bordered gray white, large orange-ochre spot, veined and dotted darker, beards orange and rust.

**\$5 EMERALD FANTASY** OGB+ (Tate by Shepard 1983) Creamy lavender ground with heavy webbing of rich dark purple, solid up midrib of standards; black signal with greenish cast; black beard; burgundy-red style arms; slight fragrance.

**\$5 ENGRAVED** OB- (T Craig 1953) White to pearl-grey, heavily veined deep grey.

**\$7 FIESTA SKIRT** OGB (Shockey 2004) S. light amethyst violet, midrib darker; style arms light golden buff; F. warm brown, edges lighter, large somewhat oblong signal dark grayed purple; beard dark red purple

**\$25 GALILEE DEEPS** - See Introductions

**\$6 GALILEE PRINCE** OH (l. Danielson 1993) S. ruffled deep rose-wine, densely veined darker; style crests same; F. black rose-wine shading lighter toward hafts with dark (almost black) veining; black signal; maroon-black beards.

- \$5 GELEE ROYALE** OGB (Mathes 1982) S. olive brown-yellow self with blue spot on falls
- \$5 GENETIC ARTIST** RB (Danielson 1972) Odd combination of bronzy yellow and blue; center of petals to sides of ribs metallic lavender blue, edges strongly colored red bronze with tints of henna; beard lavender
- \$5 GENETIC BURST** RB- (H. Danielson 1976) S. oyster white; F. light blue; electric blue beard.
- \$5 GHOST DANCER** OGB (McAllister 1992) S. wisteria; F. smoky amethyst burgundy black spots on signal area, burgundy black beards.
- \$5 GIDEON'S LAMP** OGB (McGrath 2005) S. white, slight yellow flush at base of midrib; F. white washed strongly with bright yellow, very intense color surrounding large brown chevron shaped signal; beard white tipped yellow
- \$25 GILBOAN FAWN** - See Introductions
- \$8 GO BIG RED** OGB (McAllister 2006) S. medium violet, darker veining, gold flush up midrib; style arms orange yellow; F. blood red, black signal surrounding tip of beard; beards money gold tipped old gold.
- \$6 HANNAH'S PRAYER** OGB (McGrath 2005) S. rich lavender veined darker, style arms gold with light lavender midrib; F. gold washed lavender at edges, rich gold surrounding large near black signal lightly veined; beards dark gold tipped darker.

- \$5 HEIMDALL** OGB (Mathes, 1995). Medium to dark blue-violet; black signal; blue-violet beard tipped mustard. tipped mustard LIMITED

**\$5 JABAL KERAK OGB** (White 1955) White and pale lemon yellow; primuline yellow beard; dahlia purple signal patch

**\$5 JACOB’S WELL OBG** (Brizendine 1986) S. Dark velvety brown; F. dark brown; bronze brown beard

**\$5 JADE AR** (Abell 1963) S. light cobalt, light fern-green pattern; F. light cobalt, lavender-green pattern, light cobalt beard, brushed yellow.

**\$5 JALLAB OGB-** (Keppel 2003) S. light grayed lavender washed and blended ecru chartreuse toward edge, base rattan; style arms clear yellow; F. reddish brown wash on rattan; beard chrome yellow to cadmium yellow in throat

**\$5 JAZZ BABY OGB-** (Noyd 1960) S. light orchid blue; F. light green splashed violet

**\$5 JEWEL OF OMAR OB-** (Boswell,1986). S. medium blue, purple at base; greenish-yellow styles; F. medium lime-yellow, maroon-brown around violet beard.

**\$5 JOINT VENTURE OGB-** (McAllister 1992) S. amethyst violet; F. grayed yellow flushed reddish gray, near black underlay around beard to fainter near the edge; brown black beard tipped red.

**\$6 JUDEAN ROUGE OGB+** (Clark by Leech 1970) S. clear baby ribbon pink; F yellowish tan with brown veining, large dark brown signal; bronze beard

**\$5 KALIFA'S HORN OGB-** (Annand 1995) S. orchid lavender, flecked darker; style arms lavender bronze; F. orchid lavender, flecked paler below beard; pale yellow haft infusion; bronze beard; lavender horn.

**\$5 KALIFA'S ROBE OGB** (Hager 1990). S. intense fuchsia orchid; rosy terracotta styles; F. rosy terracotta; diffuse blackish beard almost covering large blackish signal

**\$5 KHYBER PASS OGB** (Kidd 1981) S. light lavender with darker veining; F. tan with maroon dotting and veining, heavier at hafts, small signal of dark maroon; brown beard

**\$5 KIOSK OGB** (Hager 1986) Yellow self, brown black signal; yellow beard

**\$5 KOKO KNOLL OGB+** (Hunt by McAllister 1984) S. old gold flushed brown at base; F. old gold heavily veined and dotted reddish-brown, appearing almost solid rust-red; less intense veining around mustard beard giving appearance of yellow accent marks.

**\$5 KUZA NAMA OGB** (Hager 1983) S. deep amethyst veined deeper bronze at midrib; F. glowing bronze, reddish blended area in center; veined around bronze beard.

**\$5 LADY MOHR OB-** (Salbach, 1943). S. pearly white; F. pale yellow; veined and dotted brownish-purple around beard.

**\$8 LAKESIDE ELF OGB** (Moran R. 2006) S. clear pale lavender, style arms lavender blushed yellow; F. light tan infused with red veins radiating from red signal that is darker around beard; beards old gold tipped light yellow. Parentage unknown, seed from SIGNA.

**\$5 LANCER OGB** (Shockey 1994) Medium light orchid-violet; very large and sharp near-black pointed signal; old gold beard.

**\$5 LAND OF ENCHANTMENT OGB** (McAllister 1992) S. lilac; F soft chrome yellow, heavily blushed oxblood, giving overall dark adobe brick effect; signal area heavily dotted and veined burgundy
