INFORMATION ABOUT BECOMING A DISPLAY GARDEN FOR THE ARIL SOCIETY INTERNATIONAL

The requirements are simple and few:

1. You must be a member of ASI.
2. You need to be growing a representative number of arils and arilbreds. There is no minimum requirement. If you feel you grow enough to make a trip to your garden worthwhile then you qualify.
3. You must make your garden available to visitors during bloom season.
4. You must complete and return an annual report. This report shares information on your garden successes, failures and favorites with the rest of ASI's members.

Things that are not necessary:

1. You do not have to be an AIS judge.
2. You do not have to grow every new Aril and Arilbred on the market.
3. You do not have to have an acre of land devoted to iris.
4. You do not have to accept guest iris from hybridizers. Although if you have the space and the time this can be a lot of fun for you and beneficial to our hybridizers
5. You do not have to hybridize iris.
